The Book of Acts

Chapter 2

I. Coming of the Holy Spirit vs. 1-10

- a. When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, vs. 1-2
- b. Then there appeared to them divided tongues, as of fire, vs. 3-4
- c. And there were dwelling in Jerusalem Jews, devout men, from every nation under heaven. vs. 5-6
- d. How is it that we hear, each in our own language in which we were born? vs. 7-8
- e. Visitors from Rome, both Jews and proselytes, vs. 9-10

II. Peter's Sermon vs. 11-20

- a. So they were all amazed and perplexed, saying to one another, "Whatever could this mean?" vs. 11-12
- b. Others mocking said, "They are full of new wine." vs. 13-14
- c. For these are not drunk, as you suppose, since it is only the third hour of the day. vs. 15-16
- d. And it shall come to pass in the last days, says God, that I will pour out of My Spirit on all flesh; vs. 17-18
- e. I will show wonders in heaven above and signs in the earth beneath: vs. 19-20

III. Peter explains the resurrected Jesus vs. 21-30

- a. That whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved.' vs. 21-22
- b. Whom God raised up, having loosed the pains of death, vs. 23-24
- c. 'I foresaw the Lord always before my face,' vs. 25-26
- d. For You will not leave my soul in Hades, nor will You allow Your Holy One to see corruption. vs. 27-28

e. He would raise up the Christ to sit on his throne, vs. 29-30

IV. Peter explains the Divine Messiah vs. 31-40

- a. This Jesus God has raised up, of which we are all witnesses. vs. 31-32
- b. Therefore being exalted to the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, vs. 33-34
- c. "Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly that God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ." vs. 35-36
- d. Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; vs. 37-38
- e. For the promise is to you and to your children, vs. 39-40

V. A Vital Church Grows vs. 41-47

- a. Then those who gladly received his word were baptized; and that day about three thousand souls were added to them. vs. 41-42
- b. These all continued with one accord in prayer and supplication, with the women. vs. 43-44
- c. Sold their possessions and goods, and divided them among all, as anyone had need. vs. 45-46
- d. The Lord added to the church daily those who were being saved.
